DRUGS POLICY

- 1). Any person convicted of an offence under the current law/legislation pertaining to the misuse of drugs or under the current drug trafficking law/legislation, whether in the Bailiwick of Guernsey or under current law/legislation elsewhere, shall be ineligible for selection in Guernsey Softball Association representative squads and by Guernsey Softball Association full Member clubs at any level *sine die*.
- 2). Any person convicted of an offence under the current law/legislation pertaining to the misuse of drugs or under the current drug trafficking law/legislation, whether in the Bailiwick of Guernsey or under current law/legislation elsewhere, shall be ineligible to hold any office, coaching position, team representative position or any position whatsoever, within the Guernsey Softball Association or within Guernsey Softball Association full Member clubs at any level and shall not be permitted to be inscribed on the Official List of Umpires, *sine die*.
- 3). At the expiration of a period of two (2) years following a conviction, a person may be eligible for selection or appointment, however, such person will be ineligible to hold any office, coaching position, team representative position or any other position whatsoever, within the Guernsey Softball Association or within Guernsey Softball Association full Member clubs for a further one (1) year period in respect of Junior/Youth Softball involvement.

NOTE: Should any person receive another relevant conviction, during an initial or subsequent period of exclusion or ban, then a new period of exclusion or ban will commence as above from the date of the latest conviction.
